I first saw GODSPELL back when I was in high school, and immediately fell in love with the music and the sense of fun and community that permeates every part of the show.


Ella Bordeaux

TIM O'CONNOR (Director, Producer and CEO)

Tim grew up dreaming of a life in the theatre, and over the last twenty years has built an impressive career not only as a theatre director and producer, but also as a mentor, a teacher and an inspirational speaker. As a producer and director, Tim has worked with some of Australia's most respected performers, having directed *Daryl Somers* in GUYS & DOLLS, *Rhonda Burchmore, Rachael Beck* and *Eddie Perfect* in INTO THE WOODS and *Frank Woodley, Simon Gallaher, Ion English* and *Julie Anthony* in SPAMALOT (which won a Matilda Award for Best Musical in 2014). He also produced the 30th anniversary production of THE PIRATES OF PENZANCE at QPAC, starring *Andrew O'Keefe, Nancye Hayes* and *John Wood* and directed by *Simon Gallaher.* Tim masterminded the concept of Harvest Rain's arena musicals with their first arena production of CATS starring Marina Prior, and has since produced the national tours of HAIRSPRAY - THE BIG FAT ARENA SPECTACULAR, GREASE - THE ARENA EXPERIENCE and THE WIZARD OF OZ - ARENA SPECTACULAR. He will next produce and direct Harvest Rain's arena production of WE WILL ROCK YOU in 2021. Tim is the author of the book DAREDEVIL DREAMER, the founder of the Brisbane Academy of Musical Theatre and the CEO of Harvest Rain Theatre Company, the world's largest youth arts organisation.
